<p>1. The need for the project is clearly shown.</p> <p>Refer to questions 10 and 15 in the application form.</p>	0 - Little or no evidence of need.
	10 - Sufficient evidence of need.
	20 - Strong evidence of need.
<p>2. A wide range of beneficiaries will be involved.</p> <p>Refer to questions 3g) and 16b) in the application form and page 13 of the guide for applicants (equal opportunities).</p>	0 - Some people who could benefit will be excluded
	10 - The project will be open to all who could benefit
	20 - The project will actively seek to involve a wider range of beneficiaries
<p>3. The project will achieve the programme outcomes</p> <p>Refer to questions 17 and 10 in the application form and page 11 of the guidance notes. Questions 17 and 10 are the main source of reference for outcomes, however information provided throughout the application form should be used to support the scoring of this criteria.</p>	0 - The project does not meet any of the BIG outcomes
	40 - The project will bring about changes that meet one BIG outcome
	60 - The project will bring about changes that meet two or more BIG outcomes
<p>4. The applicant has not received funding from A4A.</p>	0 - The applicant has received A4A funding in the last three years
	10 - The applicant has received A4A funding but not in the last three years
	20 - The applicant has never received A4A funding before.
<p>5. The applicant is a small organisation</p> <p>Refer to questions 2 and 6 in the application form and page 6 of the guide.</p>	0 - The most recent annual income of the applicant is more than £70,000
	5 - The most recent annual income of the applicant is between £30,001 and £70,000
	10 - The most recent annual income of the applicant is between £10,001 and £30,000
	20 - The most recent annual income of the applicant is £10,000 or less
<p>6. The total project cost is small</p> <p>Refer to question 13a in the application form.</p>	0 - The total project cost is more than £25,000.
	5 - The total project cost is between £10,001 and £25,000.
	10 - The total project cost is £10,000 or less
